INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

As per the directives of Department of Expenditure, this quotation / tender document has been published on the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>). The bidders are required to submit softcopies of their bids electronically on the CPP portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates (DSC). The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP portal may be obtained at <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>

REGISTRATION

1. Bidders are required to enrol on the e-procurement module of the Central Public Procurement portal (URL: <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link, "click here to enrol". Enrolment on the CPP portal is free of charge.
2. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique user name and assign a password for their accounts.
3. Bidders are advised to register their valid e-mail address and mobile number as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
4. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (class 2 or class 3 certificates with signing key usage) issued by any certifying authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / TCS / nCode / eMudhra etc.) with their profile.
5. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse.
6. Bidder then logs into the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID Password and the password of the DSC / eToken.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

1. There are various search options built in the CPP portal to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as organization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP portal.
2. Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. The tenders can be moved to the respective "My Tenders" folder. This would enable the CPP portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
3. The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each other, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.



PREPARATION OF BIDS

1. Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
2. Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bids. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bids.
3. Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black & white option.
4. To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor's certificates, etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

1. Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he / she upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
2. The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
3. Bidder has to select the payment option as "on-line" to pay the tender fee / EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument. Whenever, EMD / Tender fees is sought, bidders need to pay the tender fee and EMD separately on-line through RTGS (Refer to Schedule, **Page no. 3**)
4. A standard BOQ Format has been provided with the tender document to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the white coloured [unprotected] cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

OR

In some cases, financial bids can be submitted in PDF format as well (in lieu of BOQ).

5. The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
6. All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot

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be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done.

7. The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorised bid openers.
8. Upon the successful and timely submission of bids, the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
9. Kindly add scanned PDF of all relevant documents in a single PDF file of compliance sheet.

ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS

Possession of a valid class II / III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in the form of smart card / e-token in the company's name is a prerequisite for registration and participating in the bid submission activities through <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. - The successful bidder shall be required to submit a performance guarantee of 5% of the estimated cost put to tender (ECPT) or Contract amount whichever is higher in the form of Bank Guarantee or F.D.R. from a Nationalized / Scheduled Bank within fifteen days of issue of letter of intent before award of work. In case of failure by the Contractor to submit the performance guarantee within the specified period, full earnest money will be forfeited by the Institute, and the tender shall be treated as null and void. EMD shall be refunded after submission of PBG. The performance guarantee shall be initially valid up to the stipulated date of completion (i.e. 06 months) plus 180 days beyond that.
- The bid will be treated as abnormally low if the quoted bid is lesser than 80% of the estimated cost put to tender.
- Requirement of Additional Performance Guarantee (APG):** In case of abnormally low bids as defined above, the bidder shall be required to submit Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) in addition to the Standard Performance Guarantee (PG) as stated above. The amount of Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) shall be equivalent to the *difference* between the 80% amount of ECPT and quoted

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amount. (e.g. if ECPT is A and quoted amount is 0.7A then the amount of APG shall be 0.8A – 0.7A). The Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) shall be in the prescribed format of Performance Guarantee and has to be submitted within the time frame prescribed for submission of Performance Guarantee. - 5) **Earnest money (EMD)** shall have to be deposited / submitted as stipulated in the schedule. **Declaration to be submitted** by the bidder as indicated in the list of mandatory documents, if scanned copy of DD / FDR is submitted For EMD.
- 6) The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of submission of financial bid.
- 7) **Similar work means: - SITC OF CCTV cameras & related works / Addition & alteration work of existing CCTV system.**
- 8) **Work means** work done with some Central Government Department / State Government Department / Central Autonomous Body / *State Autonomous Body* / Central Public Sector Undertaking / *State Public Sector Undertaking* / *City Development Authority* / *Municipal Corporation of City formed under any Act by Central / State Government and published in Central / State Gazette / Any Public Authority*.
- 9) Completion certificates are required to be got issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer of similar works completed by the Firm. The work experience certificates submitted by the bidders shall clearly indicate that:
 - i. The similar work executed shall be **as per '5' above**
 - ii. The completed cost of the work
 - iii. Actual date of completion of the work
- 10) IITD is committed to follow the principle of transparency, equity and competitiveness in public procurement. Before submission of bid, **each bidder should sign integrity pact at respective places** and submit the bid. **If duly signed integrity pact is not submitted by bidder, such bid shall not be considered.**

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- 11) **The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions [both commercial & Additional] & IITD - 6 carefully** which will be the part of the Contract. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- 12) Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- 13) The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website e-procure.gov.in free of cost.
- 14) But the bid can only be submitted after submission of **EMD as prescribed in the schedule**.
- 15) Copy of all mandatory documents as desired in the NIT shall be scanned and up-loaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified / original copy of all the scanned and up-loaded documents shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of e-tendering authority. During scrutiny of technical bids, if required, bidders may be asked to submit original documents for cross checking.
- 16) Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, who has submitted **prescribed EMD** and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

- 18) When bids are invited in two / three stages systems and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
- 19) The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.
- 20) Contractors must ensure to quote rate of each item.
- 21) **The bid submitted shall become invalid if:**
 - a) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including GSTIN registration) as stipulated in the bid document including the undertaking / declaration if any.
 - b) EMD not deposited as specified.
 - c) Not registered with EPFO & ESIC.
 - d) **Ink signed OEM authorisation letter from Pelco on OEM Letter Head Specific to this tender for execution of the pelco make CCTV camera and associated system i/c licensing at the specified locations mentioned in the SOQ.**

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **₹ 2,94,65,683.00** this estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
 - 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.
- 1.2 Intending bidder is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below: -

 - 1.2.3 **To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under: - “I / We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I / we shall be debarred for bidding in IIT Delhi in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid)”**
2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. IITD 7/8 which is available as IIT Delhi Publication. Bidders shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 06 Months from the date of start as defined in schedule ‘F’ or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. The site for the work is available.
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of

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various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen from the web Site e-procure.gov.in.

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.

 - 18.2 If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - 18.3 In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (18.1) and (18.2) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.
19. This notice inviting bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder / contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall **within fifteen days**

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the Principal / Owner has floated the Tender (NIT No.66/IITD/EW/1156/2026-2027) (here in after referred to as "**Tender/Bid**") and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for "**Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning (SITC) of CCTV System and Relocation of Old CCTV Cameras and Other Accessories at Different Locations & Hostels, including CAMC, at IIT Delhi.**" (Name of work) hereinafter referred to as the "**Contract**".

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s) AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "**Integrity Pact**" or "**Pact**"), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under:

ARTICLE 1: COMMITMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL / OWNER

1. The Principal/Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - 1.1.1 No employee of the Principal / Owner, personally or through any of his / her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - 1.1.2 The Principal/Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process,

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provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.

- 1.1.3 The Principal/Owner shall Endeavour to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.
2. If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (PoC Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

ARTICLE 2: COMMITMENT OF THE BIDDER(S) / CONTRACTOR(S)

1. It is required that each Bidder/Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standards, and report to the Government / Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or coercion or collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
2. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:
 - 2.1. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.
 - 2.2. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.
 - 2.3. The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PoC Act. Further the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal / Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
 - 2.4. The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents / representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participate in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.
 - 2.5. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.
3. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
4. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in

fraudulent practices means a wilful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.

5. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may befall upon a person, his/ her reputation or property to influence their participation in the tendering process).

ARTICLE 3: CONSEQUENCES OF BREACH

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal / Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder/ Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right:

1. If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article 2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days' notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**
2. **Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit:** If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.
3. **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal / Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

ARTICLE 4: PREVIOUS TRANSGRESSION

1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.
2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/ Owner.
3. If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner

ARTICLE 5: EQUAL TREATMENT OF ALL BIDDERS/CONTRACTORS/SUBCONTRACTORS

1. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-contractors/sub-vendors.
2. The Principal/Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
3. The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

ARTICLE 6: DURATION OF THE PACT

1. This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 6 months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.
2. If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority of IIT Delhi.

ARTICLE 7: OTHER PROVISIONS

1. This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the Head Quarters of the Division of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.
2. Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by Board Resolution.
4. Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
5. It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement / Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.

ARTICLE 8: LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

1. All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender/Contract documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.

2. COMMERCIAL CONDITIONS:
