IIT Delhi reserves the right to reject any application at any time, if it is not in the given format, a material misrepresentation is made or uncovered, or the firm does not respond promptly and thoroughly to requests for supplementary information required for the evaluation of the applications.

#### Scope of Work:

- 1. Evaluation, drafting, filing, prosecution, opposition and maintenance of Indian patent applications and patents
- 2. Evaluation, drafting, filing, prosecution, opposition and maintenance of foreign patent applications and patents
- 3. Securing registration and maintenance of copyright, Industrial design, trademark, semiconductor Integrated circuit layout design.
