In the seminar, Prof. Sally will discuss the forthcoming book, which relies on over a decade of engaged ethnography with Atacameño-Likanantay (Indigenous) peoples in the Salar de Atacama and mining company social relations employees to consider how harms to groundwater, ecology, and society may be hidden and what forms of action and events give rise to revelations.

ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Prof. Sally is an Associate Professor of anthropology at the University of Queensland, Australia who writes about the social and ecological effects of the extractive industries in Chile and Australia, especially for Indigenous Peoples. She is the author of a number of scholarly articles on these topics in the area of ecological and political anthropology. She is also author of ethnographic and historical research on Queensland.
