

Expression of Interest (EOI)

Inviting Expressions of Interest for Foreign Patent Filing and International Commercialization of IIT Delhi Technologies

1. Introduction

Indian Institute of Technology Delhi (IIT Delhi), through the Foundation for Innovation and Technology Transfer (FITT), invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from interested companies, firms, and technology transfer or licensing partners for collaboration in international commercialization of technologies developed at IIT Delhi.

The objective of this initiative is to identify organizations with expertise in global intellectual property management, international technology marketing, and licensing, who can assist in facilitating commercialization opportunities for IIT Delhi technologies in markets outside India.

2. Scope of Engagement

Interested organizations may express interest in one or more of the following areas:

- **International Licensing and Commercialization**

Identification of licensing and commercialization opportunities for IIT Delhi technologies that are already patented or protected in India for territories outside India.

- **Foreign Patent Filing and Commercialization**

Identification of promising IIT Delhi technologies with international market potential and undertaking foreign patent filings, followed by efforts for international licensing and commercialization.

Interested industry partners may have the opportunity to collaborate in advancing such technologies globally, including participation in foreign patenting and commercialization efforts, with mutually agreed cost-sharing arrangements aligned with potential commercial benefits.

- **Technology Marketing and Partner Identification**

Global outreach, industry engagement, and identification of potential licensees or commercialization partners for IIT Delhi technologies.

3. Information to be Submitted

Interested parties are requested to submit the following information:

- Organizational profile and relevant experience in technology commercialization or IP licensing
- Details of geographical markets/territories where the organization has market reach
- Brief outline of the proposed collaboration model (e.g., success-fee model, revenue sharing, etc.)
- Details of prior experience with university or academic technology licensing, if any
- Key sectors or technology domains of interest

5. Next Stage

Based on the responses received, IIT Delhi may shortlist interested organizations and invite them to submit detailed proposals under a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) process, if required.
