MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE SENATE
HELD ON 11th JUNE 2025 AT 03:00 PM
IN THE SENATE ROOM

A Special Meeting of the Senate was held on 11th June 2025 at 03:00 pm in the Senate Room. Names of Members/Special Invitees, who attended the meeting, are given in **[Appendix – A]**. Due to the non-availability of the quorum, the meeting was adjourned at 03:05 p.m. and reconvened at 03:10 p.m.

At the outset, the Chairperson Senate thanked Prof. R.S Rengasamy, Department of Textile and Fibre Engineering, outgoing member, for his valuable contributions to the Senate.

Item No. 1: To consider remaining M.Tech. and MS(R) programme templates as per new curriculum

The Senate was apprised that as per the decision in the 232nd Senate meeting, the remaining M.Tech and MS(R) programme templates of the following programmes were circulated to the Senators for comments/feedback:

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Item No. 2: To consider new course templates proposed by PG CIC

The Senate considered the new course templates proposed by the PG CIC. It was suggested to relook at the course title and the course content of the courses TRL7203 and TRL7500, respectively.

After deliberations, the new course templates proposed by the PG CIC (**Appendix 1**) were approved in-principle. It was also suggested to circulate the courses to the Senators for comments/feedback. The Senate authorized the Dean Academics and the PGCIC to approve minor changes, if any, in the course templates / course numbers.

Item No. 3: To consider new course templates of non-graded unit, 1 credit and Project type proposed by PG CIC

After deliberations, the new course templates of non-graded unit, 1 credit and Project type proposed by PG CIC (**Appendix 2**) were approved in-principle. It was also suggested to circulate the courses to the Senators for comments/feedback. The Senate authorized the Dean Academics and the PGCIC to approve minor changes, if any, in the course templates / course numbers.

Item No. 4: To consider the course template with new course number of previously approved courses with updated content

After deliberations, the course templates with new course number of the previously approved courses with updated content (**Appendix 3**) were approved in-principle. It was also suggested to circulate the courses to the Senators for comments/feedback. The Senate authorized the Dean Academics and the UGCIC/PGCIC to approve minor changes, if any, in the course templates / course numbers.

Item No. 5: To consider the MSc Biological Science, MSc Cognitive Sciences, MSc Economics and MA (Culture, Society, and Thought) programme templates as per new curriculum

The Senate considered the programme templates for the MSc Biological Science, MSc Cognitive Sciences, MSc Economics and MA (Culture, Society, and Thought) as per new curriculum.

After deliberations, the [programme templates for the MSc Cognitive Sciences, MSc Economic and MA \(Culture, Society, and Thought\)](#) were approved in-principle, subject to minor changes, if any, in the programme templates.

The [programme template for the MSc Biological Science](#) was approved in-principle, subject to minor changes, if any, in the programme template. It was suggested to incorporate the sustainability requirements.

The Senate authorized the PGCIC to make minor changes, if any, in these programme templates.

<u>RESOLUTION NO. 2025/Spl/2:</u>	RESOLVED THAT the programme templates of MSc Biological Science, MSc Cognitive Sciences, MSc Economic and MA (Culture, Society, and Thought) as per new curriculum, be approved in-principle.
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Item No. 6: To consider policy for Cross-Listing and Dual-listing of Courses

Associate Dean, Academics (Curriculum) presented the policy for Cross-Listing and Dual-Listing of courses. It was apprised that the policy is intended to provide guidelines and procedures for the cross-listing of courses between different academic units, such as Departments, Centres and Schools, and dual-listing of courses within the same unit.

The Senate discussed the matter in detail. After deliberations, the policy for Cross-Listing and Dual-Listing of courses (**Appendix 4**) was approved in-principle. The members were requested to provide comments/feedback to the Dean (Academics). The comments, if any, will be incorporated.

Item No. 7: To consider programme template of Master's in Public Policy as per the new curriculum

After deliberation, the [programme template for the Master's in Public Policy \(MPP\)](#) as per the new curriculum was approved in-principle, subject to minor changes, if any, in the programme template.

<u>RESOLUTION NO. 2025/Spl/4:</u>	RESOLVED THAT the programme template of Master's in Public Policy as per the new curriculum, be approved in-principle.
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Item No. 8: To consider the revised programme template of the B. Tech programme in Biochemical Engineering and Biotechnology

Head, DBEB apprised that the practical components for two of the courses BBL7074 and BBL7031 have been revised from 3-0-2 to 3-0-3. Thus overall, 0.5 credits have been increased in the lab component of each of these courses. This has resulted in an overall increase in credit from 149 to 150. These two courses have been dual listed for both UG and PG students.

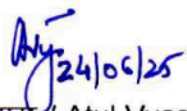

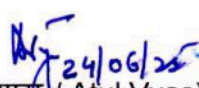
