1. Facilities, requirements and provisions for online teaching ↩

- Course coordinator will inform the mode of online (live or video recorded, and lecture notes) delivery of course content.
- Course content (lectures etc.) will be available on Impartus platform. The access will be through Moodle system with access through your Kerberos id.
- Some of the course content and doubt clearing may be live sessions.

2. Modification and communication of course evaluation policy ↩

- Due to change in conditions, the course evaluation policy may be suitably adjusted and communicated by course coordinator.
- The course evaluation policy will be communicated either through the Academics ERP system or the course email.
- Senate resolved provisions for course evaluation policy for the semester
 - Attendance in online classes or in on campus classes cannot be used as basis for grading or any other aspects related to course evaluation policy, in semesters which are partly or fully completed online.
 - The minimum pass requirement for a course done on credit basis ('D' grade) or on Audit basis ('NP' grade) is to be fixed at 30% marks.

3. Audit a course ↩

As a special provision, you may audit one course this semester. However, for students interested in possible branch change, this option may not be exercised as auditing a course will make you **ineligible** for **change of discipline** after first year. For auditing a course, the process will be announced by the ERP team.

4. First day for part-evaluations/ assignment submission ↩

To provide students some time for preparation, in-semester evaluation should be scheduled on or after August 13, 2020. Assignments can be given earlier, but the due dates for assignments must be on or after August 13, 2020.

5. Minor/ Major exam/ evaluations related details ↩

Schedule will be provided by Chairman, Time-Table Committee for these exams/ evaluations. In view of different way of conducting these evaluations with remotely located students, the schedule will include only the end time. The submission from students must not be before the end time given in the schedule and the exam/ evaluation can be started at any suitable time before the end time ensuring that it

does not overlap with the previously scheduled slot. The mode and other details of the exam/ evaluation will be communicated by the course coordinator.

6. Pre-registration for the next semester ↩

Pre-registration for the next semester will be on the Academics ERP system. Detailed process will be announced before the start of the pre-registration.
