Sub.: Shortlisting criteria for foreign students in M. Tech. Programmes (JES, ESN & ESR)

1. The shortlisting criteria for admission of foreign students in M.Tech. Programmes in “Energy Studies (JES)”, “Energy & Environment Technologies and Management (ESN)” and “Renewable Energy Technologies and Management (ESR)” for Academic session 2020-2021 is given in the Table below:

Eligible Disciplines (ESR: sponsored programme)	<i>Minimum 4-year / equivalent</i> Bachelors Degree in Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering, Energy Engineering, Engineering Physics, Industrial Engineering, Industrial Physics, Mechanical Engineering, Power Engineering, Renewable Energy Engineering, OR Masters Degree in Physics, Electronics, Applied Physics.
Duration of study for qualifying degree	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Bachelors degree programmes must be at least of 4-year duration. ➤ Students with Masters Degree need to have completed at least 3 years in the undergraduate level and at least 2 years in the post graduate level.
Shortlisting criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. UG/PG Marks: Percentage $\geq 60\%$ or CGPA : $\geq 6.00/10.00$ ii. Candidates need to provide a statement / self-declaration on their proficiency in English. If available, scores in English language proficiency tests such as TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, OPI, OPIC, Cambridge English Examination, etc. can be considered as an additional input. iii. Candidate must provide names and contact details (email, phone number, official address) of at least two referees from whom recommendation letters about the candidate would be asked for over email before the interviews. The referee would need to comment about the candidate’s overall aptitude, proficiency in chosen field, potential for research and independent thinking as well as proficiency in oral and written English. iv. For sponsored / part time students minimum one-year work experience is required as on date of registration. v. For ESR programme, only sponsored full time / part time students will be considered. vi. Shortlisted candidates, based upon satisfaction of above criteria, shall have to appear for an interview, through video conferencing between 08/06/2020 [Monday] and 12/06/2020 [Friday]. Exact date and time will be intimated in due course.

2. Employees of only those organizations which are located within 50 Kilometers radius of IIT Delhi are eligible to be considered for admission to part-time M.Tech. programmes.
3. **Sponsored (full-time) candidates** seeking admission to this M.Tech programme on the basis of study leave, must submit a “Sponsorship certificate” on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following:
- a. for the period of his/her studies in the programme, the candidate would be treated as on duty with usual salary and allowances, and
 - b. that he/she will be fully relieved and granted study leave for a minimum period of 2 years.
4. **Working professionals** are required to submit a “No Objection Certificate” on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following:
- a. the candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis
 - b. that his/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for studies - that he/she will not be transferred to any other place during the period of study
5. Shortlisted candidates to be interviewed via video-conferencing between 08/06/2020 [Monday] and 12/06/2020 [Friday]. Exact date and time will be intimated in due course.
6. If any candidate is fulfilling the above mentioned criteria but he/she has not been called for interview before 01/06/2020, he/she may contact CES office through phone (+91-011-26591251) or email (hodces@admin.iitd.ac.in) for any clarification before the start date of the interviews (08/06/2020).
