1. The shortlisting criteria for admission of M.Tech. Programme in Energy Studies (JES), M. Tech. in Energy & Environment Technologies and Management (ESN) as well as the sponsored programme of M. Tech. Renewable Energy Technologies and Management (ESR) for Academic session 2020-2021 is given in the Table below:

2. CRC approved the above mentioned eligible disciplines for the three different programmes (JES, ESN and ESR) as per above table. Disciplines other than those listed above will not be considered for admission in JES, ESN and ESR programmes.
3. ***For ESR programme, only sponsored full time / part time students will be considered. No Institute Assistantship will be provided for ESR programme.***
4. For all candidates with B.Tech. from IITs with a CGPA of 8.0 or above, the requirement of qualification through GATE is waived off.
5. The final selection for the programme for full time students with GATE Score will be based purely on GATE score whereas others, including those who qualify under point 4 above, will have to appear for an interview via video-conferencing between 08/06/2020 [Monday] and 12/06/2020 [Friday]. Exact date and time will be intimated in due course.
6.
