Agreement on Cooperation
between
Indian Institutes of Technology Delhi
and
TU9 German Universities of Technology e. V.

The Indian Institutes of Technology Delhi (IITD) and the TU9 German Universities of Technology, referred to here as "networks", are mutually interested in continuing their co-operation within the framework of activities under the auspices of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD).

For this purpose, both networks will continue to participate in the IIT-Master-Sandwich program for another 5 years (2018–2022) according to the rules laid down by the signatories, the Indian and the German government.

This includes the exchange of students:

- a. The exchange students will remain enrolled at their home university. The students will also be enrolled at the receiving university.
- b. The exchange students will pay tuition only, if required, at their home institution.
- c. The home university is responsible for the testing of the exchange students' foreign language skills.
- d. DAAD will provide scholarships to the extent available.
- e. The program focuses on students aiming for the degree "Master of Technology" (M.Tech.) at one of the IITs and intending to use their stay at the German host University to work on a research project for their Master's thesis.
- f. The IIT universities must document the pre-selection of applicants and submit the documentation to the DAAD regional office in New Delhi.
- g. Applications by female and disadvantaged students should be preferred.
